Passage 1

Steps to Prevent Internet Crimes

The Internet has been a common part of our daily life. As millions of people have access to the Internet, criminals look for potential victims online. Children are especially vulnerable to online predators. Criminals may lure them into inappropriate chat rooms or ask them to go out, which may do them great harm. Here are a few ideas to protect yourself and your family from becoming a victim of Internet crimes.

Install anti-spyware and antivirus software. Anti-spyware helps prevent spyware from being used. Installing antivirus software helps prevent your computer from being infected with a virus.

Turn on your firewall. This helps prevent hackers from getting information such as passwords to bank accounts and other information they could use to steal funds or steal your identity.

Help your children choose the websites they go to. Set rules and limits for your children to use the Internet. Use software that blocks out certain inappropriate websites in case you can't keep an eye on them all the time.

Talk with your children about Internet crimes. Tell children to talk to you about anything that happens inappropriate to them online.

Use secured websites when purchasing items online and giving credit card numbers. When you are suspicious of the website, check it out before you pay any money.

Report suspected Internet crimes. You can contact your local police office to report Internet crimes and they will send a special agent to look into the matter.

作文评分标准

(1)评分原则

①本题总分为20分,按6个档次给分。

②评分时,先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次,最后给分。

③评分时应注意的主要内容为:内容要点、句型变化、词汇运用和语法结构的准确性,语意的连贯性、逻辑性以及应用文的格式要求。

④评分时,如拼写错误较多,书写较差,以至影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
